Remarks (Concerning the part-time job during the 1st school year):

1. • Step 1: ARC Application and Acquisition • Step 2: Work Permit Application (the entire process will take about 2 months)

2. From the 2nd school year, students will have internships in the JMC. Each semester will take maximum 480 hours for the internship. The internship allowance is paid according to the hourly minimum wage which is regulated in Taiwan Labor Standards Act.

3. The students who need part-time job support are able to work at JMC or another place. During the semester students are able to work 80 hours per month(20 hours per week). During the winter and summer break, part-time job working hour will not be limited by 20 hours per week. The hourly wage is according to Taiwan Labor Standards Act hourly mage.

4. When the students take the part-time job at JMC, the total hours of internship and part-time job are limited by 40 hours per week.

5. From the 3rd -5th semesters, the internship in JMC is required courses, however from the 6th -8th semesters are selected courses. Students are able to decide to select an internship course according to their study plan.



CHINESE LANGUAGE COURSES

IPIAC professional courses are taught in English. However, for students to adapt to Taiwan's life, IPIAC includes Chinese language courses in the first school year. In addition, a Chinese language certificate tutoring course will be designed so that students can obtain a Chinese language certificate with at least an A2 level before graduation.

2. Dorm fee: 1st school year apply 6 people in a room (11,000 NTD/semester). Students are able to apply 4 people in a room (16,000 NTD/semester) from 2nd school year.

3. Dorm deposit: The payment is made in first time check into the dorm and will be refunded when the accommodation contract is expired and without violation.

4. National Health Insurance: After the students enter the collaboration company for internship from 2nd school year, the company will help them apply for NHI. The payment of NHI will be deducted directly from the internship allowance.

5. Shu-Te University offers scholarship: Grant partial semester tuition fees in 50% discount during 4 years study.
